The Ottawa Hospital (TOH)

- TOH is the largest acute care hospital in the country, serving 1.2 million residents of Ottawa and Eastern Ontario
- TOH is the regional hub for treating complex illnesses and traumatic injuries
- It provides innovative, specialized care for thousands of patients and touches the lives of one in two people in Eastern Ontario every year
- The Ottawa Hospital has three campuses: General, Civic and Riverside
- There are more than 1 million outpatient visits to the Hospital every year
- Last year, there were 137,806 visits to the Emergency Department

The Ottawa Hospital Cancer Program

- The Ottawa Hospital Cancer Centre (TOHCC) is the hub of cancer care in the region
- TOHCC currently treats **24,000 patients a year**, that's **198,000 patient visits** every year
- In December 2009, we opened the expanded Ottawa Hospital Cancer Centre at the General Campus, and in April 2010, a **satellite site, the Irving Greenberg Family Cancer Centre**, opened at the Queensway Carleton Hospital
- More than half of the patients in hospital at any one time are being treated for cancer or cancer-related illnesses
- More than **80% of cancer surgeries** in the region are performed at TOH
- Last year, for the nearly 80,000 surgical procedures that were conducted at TOH, 60% of those were for cancer or cancer-related illnesses
- **90% of all chemotherapy treatments** and **100% of all radiation treatments** in Ottawa and Eastern Ontario take place at TOH
- **9,000 people will be diagnosed with cancer in our region this year**, and they will turn to TOHCC for their care

The Ottawa Hospital Research Institute

- The Ottawa Hospital Research Institute (OHRI) is the research arm of TOH
- It is one of the **fastest growing** and most respected hospital-based research institutes in Canada
- The OHRI has **more than 527 scientists and investigators** working on some **861 research projects**
- OHRI scientists are leading the way in finding new treatments and possible cures for diseases such as cancer, diabetes, arthritis and Parkinson's
